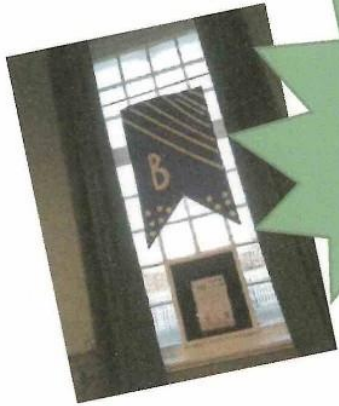


Years 5 and 6
