

Curriculum Intent

At Southwold Primary and Nursery School, we believe that Art and Design stimulates creativity and imagination. It provides visual, tactile, and sensory experiences and opens opportunities for children to feel engaged, inspired and challenged through the work of artists.

Our Art curriculum enables all children to communicate what they see, feel, and think through colour, texture, pattern, and different processes. They explore ideas and meanings through the work of artists and designers. Through learning about the functions of art, children can both reflect and shape our history and explore the impact it has on contemporary life and that of different times and cultures.

By being an inclusive school, all children will have access to a range of well taught skills and techniques from the start of their school life at Southwold. Evidence can be seen in their sketchbooks and A3 art folder they carry through their time at Southwold and celebrate the journey of skills leading to their final outcome.

Curriculum Impact

Ongoing formative assessment takes place throughout the year via lesson observations, pupil voice and book looks. Teachers use this information to inform future lessons; ensuring children are supported and challenged appropriately. Age related expectation levels are reported to the parents at the end of the academic year.
