By the end of KS2, Southwold children will have:

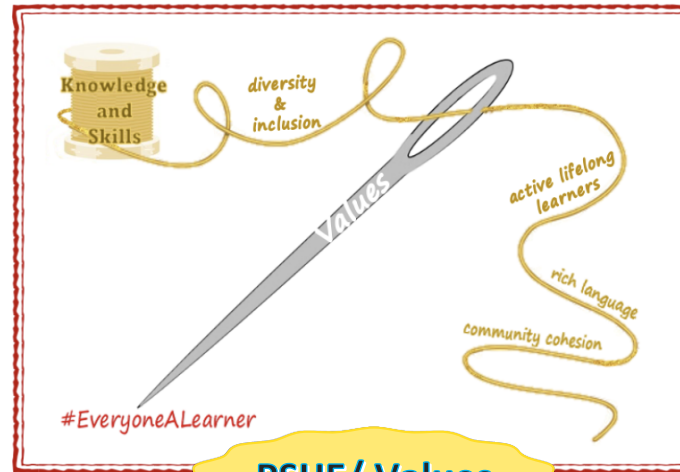
- The tools to become active and responsible citizens.

Curriculum Implementation

Our curriculum is based on the Jigsaw scheme of work which covers the same areas for each year group, ensuring that progression is clearly shown as the children gain in knowledge and experience.

This scheme follows the key themes as follows:

- Autumn 1: Being Me in My World
- Autumn 2: Celebrating Difference (including anti-bullying)
- Spring 1: Dreams and Goals
- Spring 2: Healthy Me
- Summer 1: Relationships
- Summer 2: Changing Me (including Sex Education)

Health education, relationships education and RSE is taught sensitively in accordance with DfE statutory guidance. We have a two-year cycle where these values are interwoven throughout everyday life at Southwold and promoted through highlighting the children's use of value suns in each lesson. Each term, a new value is introduced through a whole school assembly, and end each term, with an assembly where children are rewarded for showing that month's value.
