Entry Requirements

Sept.

- One entry per child
- Story must be written by the child
- Each story should clearly focus on one mathematical topic
- Where possible, **students' own drawings** are strongly encouraged to avoid any copyrights issues;
- You can use any genre
- All entries must not exceed 10 A4 pages (excluding front and back covers) consider using our suggested mathematical story picture book template
- The front cover must contain: I) the story's title; 2) the names of the author and their school.
- All pages should be numbered (excluding front and back covers)
- All entries should be submitted in the 'portrait' format (as opposed to the 'landscape' format);

All KS2 entries have the chance to be put through for an official Maths Through Stories Competition.
