Hot Weather Update and Parents Evening

The weather has been very hot this week and although we have not had a MET weather warning issued yet, we have been monitoring the impact of the heat closely.

Thursday is forecast to be the warmest day of the week, with temperatures around 33 degrees. We are reviewing all offsite trips and will only be able to continue with those which will have air-conditioned routes.

We will be closing the dining hall on Wednesday and Thursday (and possibly on Friday) due to the heat and pupils will eat in their classrooms. This protocol was put in place in the previous heatwave in June and pupils managed this well.

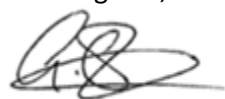
