Wednesday Update: Hot Weather Warnings

We have had very hot temperatures today and the red weather warning continues into Thursday. A amber weather warning has now been issued for Friday and predicted temperatures are set to match or exceed the temperature we have had today.

Temperatures across the school have been very high both inside and outside. We have now closed the playground and have had to reduce the number of pupils who are able to use the Sports Hall at one time. We have closed the dining hall and pupils will have their lunch in the classroom. A modified lunch menu is in effect to reduce the use of ovens.

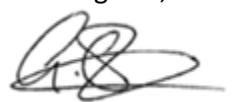
A reminder that a red alert means that there is an increased risk of dehydration, heat stress and heat exhaustion.
