

ART: Landscapes

By taking part in creative activities in the art room, learners develop practical skills and a strong awareness of health and safety, enabling them to work confidently and responsibly.

COMPUTING: Data Information - Spreadsheets

Students will build skills in using spreadsheets, starting with identifying and inputting information. Most will learn to add and use images for counting, while advanced learners will solve simple numerical problems and independently use 2Calculate.

COOKING: Celebrations

Students will develop practical culinary skills by preparing international dishes for celebratory events, focusing on new techniques and confidence in diverse cooking.

DESIGN & TECHNOLOGY: African and Jamaican Patterns

In this unit, students will learn to identify and analyse different patterns, enhancing their creativity and critical thinking in various contexts.

DRAMA: Intro to Commedia dell 'Arte / Greek Chorus Ensemble Work

This unit develops students' performance and analytical skills through Commedia dell'arte, including its history, characters, improvisation, and influence, ending with collaborative performances.

ENGLISH: Non-Fiction - Instructions

By the end of this unit, students will confidently follow instructions, write clear command sentences, and use imperative verbs effectively, enhancing their communication and literacy skills.

MATHS: Homeware Shops / Recipes

This unit will develop students' everyday maths skills, covering money, shopping, food choices, fractions, decimals, percentages, measurement, and basic operations, while building vocabulary and confidence in estimation and data analysis.

MUSIC: Ensemble skills

Throughout this unit, students will enhance teamwork and compositional skills, perform together, use graphic notation, and evaluate performances to improve musical vocabulary.

PE: Field Hockey

This unit develops the core skills needed for field hockey, focusing on dribbling, passing, and shooting. Students will build confidence and improve their abilities, while also learning principles of attack and defence through team practice and role rotation.

PSHE: Healthy Relationships and Consent

Students will learn to recognise safe and unsafe contact, seek consent, resolve conflicts respectfully, and identify trusted adults. They will practise respectful communication, understand consent online and offline, and know how to ask for help.

SCIENCE: Living Eggs – Life Cycles

In this unit, students will investigate bird species, their life cycles, and chick care, while developing skills in predicting, observing, measuring, and presenting scientific findings.

SOCIAL COMMUNICATION: Mindful Interactions

This unit helps students develop mindful social engagement by practising pausing, listening, recognising emotions, and responding appropriately through activities such as role-play and real-life scenarios.
