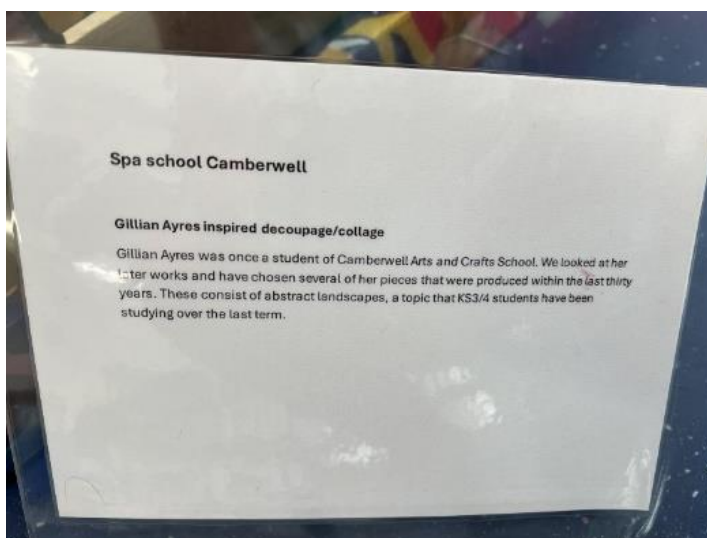


Share your views
