

Maths Visiting a local shop

Through the theme of visiting a local shop, pupils will develop their understanding of number, shape, space and measure and data handling. They will use and apply their maths skills based on individual next steps.

English Instructions & Explanations / Signs, labels & lists

Pupils will learn about features of explanations before going on to write their own based on a game show. Others will learn how to write signs, labels, captions and lists. They will understand how to use extended noun phrases and exclamation marks.

Social Communication Teamwork

Pupils will develop their skills when working with others in a range of settings, develop confidence and communication skills and reflect on their own behaviour when working with others.

PSHE Keeping safe and managing risk / People who help us

Pupils will learn how to interact with others in a safe way and the importance of being safe when playing or interacting with others. Pupils will identify people who can help them in the community, identify risks and learn how to keep themselves safe.

Science Electrical devices

Pupils will learn how to be safe when they use electrical devices. They will begin to learn about electrical circuits, how to build it and how it works. Pupils will test conductors of electricity and make generalisations based on their observations.

Humanities Worship

Pupils will focus on aspects of worship across different faiths. They will explore what worship is, what it means to religious believers and how believers worship differently. They will learn about worship through music and objects and discuss freedom to worship around the world

Music Understanding pitch - Glockenspiel

Pupils will learn about pitch by learning to play the glockenspiel and using the interactive music site Charanga. They will identify the relationship notes have to one another and learn about repeated patterns of 'musical motifs'. Students will be introduced to musical notation and begin to understand its relation to instruments and sound.

Drama An introduction to drama

Pupils will be introduced to a range of drama techniques. They will develop skills through exploration and rehearse and prepare a scene as an ensemble for an invited audience where appropriate.

Computing Making music / Sound and music presentation

Pupils will compare digital and non-digital music and create music for a given purpose. They will also choose an app or software to create music using rhymes and patterns.

Cooking Healthy Snacks

Pupils will continue to develop their skills in kitchen. They will also learn about the importance of eating a healthy breakfast and that fruit and vegetables form an important part of a balanced diet.

PE Games

Pupils are introduced to the skills needed to play team games. They will be encouraged to develop their knowledge and skills to enable them to make meaningful contributions as part of a team.

Art Recycled Art - Robots

Pupils will develop and extend their knowledge of recycled art and construction techniques. They will engage in a design process in which they are encouraged to evaluate progress made throughout the project, highlighting areas of success and areas of development.
