

Maths The School Environment

Pupils will develop their understanding of fractions, decimals, percentages, shape, pattern and symmetry and use and apply their maths skills and demonstrate progress by solving worded problems.

English A Midsummer Night's Dream

Pupils will explore the play through storybooks, scripts, and videos. They will develop their understanding by speculating, hypothesising, imagining, and exploring ideas. They will also participate in performances of the play and learn to identify the audience for and the purpose of the writing. Other pupils will encounter and passively accept tactile and multi-sensory experiences related to the text. They will begin to use words from the text in other contexts.

SoCo Learning to Accept Others

Pupils will develop tolerance of others at school, including sharing a space and completing work with others, an understanding of their relationships with others and strategies to help them tolerate less preferred peers

PSHE Keeping Safe Online / People Who Can Help Me

Pupils will describe strategies to be safe online. They will learn about and analyse strategies to avoid online fraud. Other pupils will recognise different safe adults in school and the community and learn to identify a safe adult to ask for help in real-life situations.

Science Plants and Photosynthesis

Pupils will learn about photosynthesis and its role in their diets, the requirements for photosynthesis to occur and the importance of plants in producing oxygen and food. Other pupils will learn that plants are alive, that they can grow, that they need light, and water, and that they grow from seeds.

Humanities Communication – Now and Then

Pupils will study communication now and then. They will learn about Egyptian hieroglyphics, the invention of the telephone, the printing press and the Internet.

Music Baroque and Pop!

Pupils will revise elements of baroque music and explore its use of instrumentation and compositional techniques. Pupils will discover how pop artists of today use baroque composers as inspiration for their own music. Pupils will listen to, compose, perform and evaluate music to gain a deeper understanding of how composers throughout time have used different compositional devices.

Drama The Iron Man / Introduction to Puppetry

Pupils will explore the characters and events of the book beyond the realm of the text. The text will become a springboard for further imaginative work. Other pupils will explore and create a range of puppets. They will use puppets to explore characterisation.

Computing Digital Writing / Scratch

Pupils will create and format text and images for a purpose and use formatting tools to create an effective layout. Other pupils will learn to make a simple code and use coding to create a story.

Cooking Hot and Happening

Pupils will develop competencies in cooking techniques for main meals, including frying, boiling, grilling and baking. They will develop their skills in the kitchen, e.g. listening to instructions, following a recipe, using equipment and preparing ingredients.

PE Invasion Games - Football

Pupils will learn to pass with the correct technique, basic control and the importance of moving after a pass, dribbling, various turning techniques to create space, heading a ball with the correct technique and using skills with greater intent and purpose.

Art Landscapes

Pupils will learn about classic and contemporary landscape artists. They will learn about the form of a landscape and experiment with different materials and techniques to create their own mixed-media landscape.
