Maths The Spa community	Pupils will develop their knowledge of number, shape, space and measure. They will use and apply their maths skills through real life problems in the Spa school community
English Leon and the Place Between & Mouse Bird Snake Wolf	Pupils will use appropriate vocabulary to describe settings, use drama and movement to explore themes and sounds from the text and identify images and words to describe a character. Pupils will develop their descriptive vocabulary and formulate arguments through debate
Social Communication Getting to know people	Pupils will communicate with a range of peers and adults using their preferred method of communication. They will develop their confidence when communicating and extend their communication skills. Pupils will develop new friendships based on common interests.
PSHE Rules that keep us safe & personal responsibility	Pupils will learn about rules in school that help to keep them safe. They will identify some of the responsibilities they have in and outside of school and begin to understand they are responsible for their own actions.
Science Changing materials	Pupils will learn that materials can be changed and that the changes are reversible or irreversible. They will identify a range of reactions whilst doing practical experiments.
Humanities Making Connections & BHM	Pupils will develop their understanding of geography and history by learning about different cultures and time periods. They will be introduced to different countries and learn about their cultures. Some pupils will learn about how prejudice occurs towards particular cultures or groups of people.
Music The Recorder	Pupils will learn to play the recorder, rehearse and perform with others. They will get the opportunity to explore, choose and organise sounds and musical ideas and listen to, internalise and recall sounds.
Drama Story Telling & Drama Skills	Pupils will learn about the foundational skills of drama through the use of cultural stories and songs. They will celebrate Black history and culture through exploring stories and songs from different countries.
Computing Programming – micro:bit & Digital Photography	Pupils will create a code and transfer it to a micro:bit. Pupils will use a range of devices to take photographs using newly acquired techniques and skills.
Cooking Fruit & Vegetables	Pupils will learn to work safely and hygienically in the kitchen by following the How to Cook safety steps during lessons. As well as learning new skills, pupils will become aware of creative and healthy ways to prepare fruit and vegetables. Some pupils will follow simple recipes with growing independence.
PE Games	Pupils will develop their skills to enable them to make meaningful contributions as part of a team. They will learn about fair play and feel a sense of accomplishment when they achieve their goals. Pupils will learn to play by rules and implement strategies associated with the games they play
