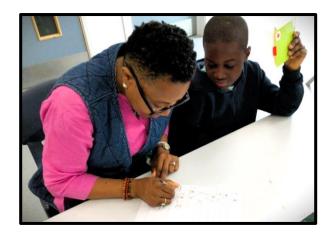
Flu Vaccinations
