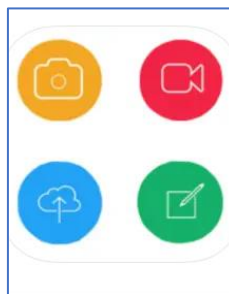
Pantomime
