Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to our last half term for this academic year. We finally have some sunshine so a few warm weather reminders for you:

- Please remember to send your son or daughter to school with their cap to protect them when they are in the playground.
- Feet and toes need to be kept safe and covered so please avoid sandals.
- Pupils wearing summer dresses must wear shorts underneath so they can play freely.
- Antihistamine medicine (like Piriton) can only be kept at school if it is prescribed. All prescribed medicines must be given to the office with the pharmacy label clearly attached.
- Do try to make sure your son / daughter applies any sunscreen needed each morning. If you want to send sunscreen to school please complete the consent slip below and return it to the office along with the sunscreen. Please make sure your child's name is clearly written on the sunscreen.
- All pupils have a school water bottle that is kept at school. We make sure they have access to water at all times to keep them hydrated.
- Do contact the office if you need to order any more school uniform. Primary pupils may not need their sweatshirts but are welcome to wear a plain white or navy polo T shirt.
