COVID Update

Two members of one class had positive PCR results last week. As we are a special school this is treated as an outbreak. I have worked closely with Public Health England and the local Covid team to make sure we are keeping everyone as safe as we can. They confirmed all the measures we have in place are safe. We are really pleased that there have been no more positive tests received this week. If your child is in KS3, I do encourage you to keep up the twice weekly home testing. If you need more kits or any help, please speak With Rian.

If your child shows any symptoms, please keep them home and seek medical advice.

If your child is over 12 years old, they are eligible for the COVID vaccine. The immunisation team are in school next week. You can register your son or daughter here. No pupil will be given the vaccine without parental consent.

Online Safety


Rian offered two online safety workshops this week. If you need more information do check the online safety on our website. We will offer more parent training in November.
