One Kind Word This week all staff and students have been taking part in activities to develop understanding around Anti-Bullying Week.

In primary, pupils have been learning to greet one another and to give and receive kindness. They have focussed on saying 'hello' in different ways: using speech, sign, songs and sound buttons, as well as practiced greeting one another in different languages.

KS3 pupils have focussed on learning one kind word for each day of the week, including: thank you, share, sorry, help, how are you? Students have been challenging themselves in class to use, or put these words into action. They have been giving and receiving compliments to one another.
