

The Coronavirus Act 2020 expired on 24 March 2022. As a result the <u>Remote</u> <u>Education (England) Temporary Continuity (No.2) direction</u> no longer has effect and we are now following the <u>Living with Covid strategy</u>.

This policy outlines guidance on how Spa Camberwell will deliver remote education in cases where it is not possible for some or all pupils to attend face-to-face education.

What Spa Camberwell will provide:

- Daily checking of how pupils learning remotely are engaging with their work, and giving support to families where needed.
- Providing support to access technology, including internet access.
- Senior Management Team to oversee the quality and delivery of remote education.

Provision for our pupils with SEND

We recognise that most of our pupils may not be able to access remote education without adult support. We will provide teaching and learning resources that are engaging, accessible and reinforce the strategies used in school. All support will be personalised to match the needs of each pupil and their family.
