Seasons and Weather Explore weather and seasons through a range of play activities. They will use a range of equipment in a sensory and functional way. Students will learn nursery rhymes and action songs related to the weather.	Seasonal Changes Understand the relationship and difference between hot and cold as well as be able to name a season and a type of weather. Make simple observations about changes across the seasons. Make comparisons between the seasons and describe the weather associated with each.	Multi-Skills Pupils will learn basic ball skills. They will learn to follow instructions and to work in small teams. Pupils will develop their hand-eye coordination and kinetic coordination.	Collage – Depicting the Seasons Explore the seasons of autumn and winter through the medium of collage. Pupils will learn to manipulate paper and other collage resources to create multi-media art works. Pupils will learn how to safely use art and craft materials.	Alternative Nursery Rhymes Listen and respond to different styles of music. Learning to sing or sign along with nursery rhymes and action songs, playing classroom instruments and, share and perform the learning that has taken place. Pupils will also get the opportunity to explore different sensory stimulus through musical experiences.
