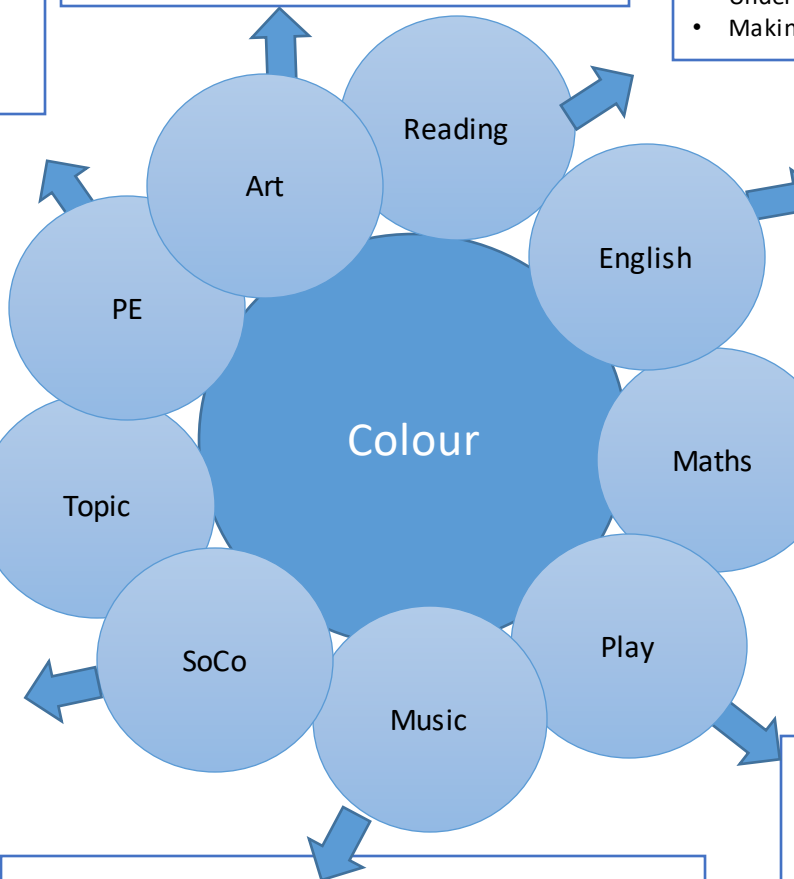
- Join attention skills
