Surprising Sharks

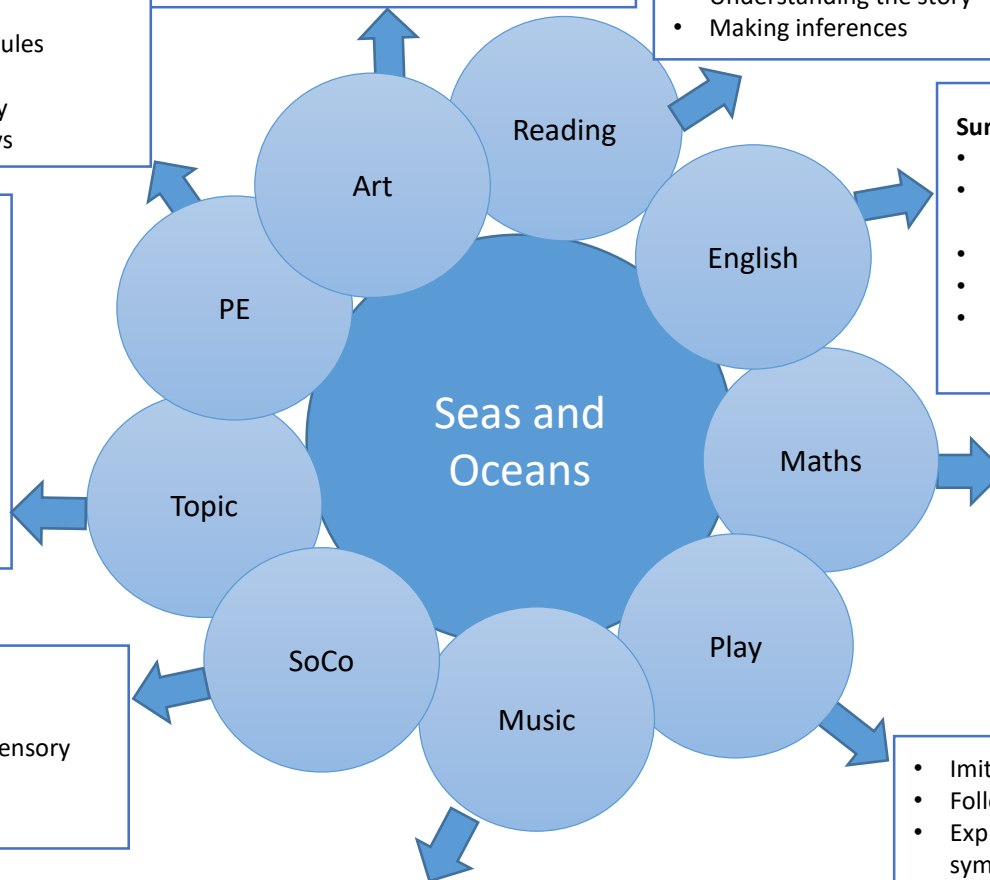
- Non-fiction
