#### Badminton

- Pupils should improve their ability to move fluently, changing speed and direction. They should continue to develop key fundamental movement skills, both with and without a ball/shuttle, improving their ability to move in a safe, controlled way.
- This unit helps children develop basic shuttle control, experiment with different types of sending and receiving, and show some success when aiming at a target. The next step is to introduce rackets.

#### Night Ferry

- Pupils will listen and reflect on 'Night Ferry' and learn how to use compositional techniques to represent the piece using colours, shapes and lines.
- Pupils will have the opportunity to play and perform in • ensemble contexts using musical instruments. They will be encouraged to improvise and compose music for a range of purposes using the interrelated dimensions of music and listen with attention to detail and recall sounds with increasing aural memory.
