

Maths

Visiting a café

Pupils will develop their understanding of number and money through number strands, their understanding of capacity and volume through shape, space and measure activities, and apply their maths skills (based on individual small steps from this strand)

English

Information texts and non-chronological reports

Pupils will learn the textual features of a non-fiction book. They will research facts, make notes and work in small groups. They will also create their own page for a group non-fiction book. Pupils will furthermore read reviews, play games and write their own game reports. Grammar activities include work on prepositions, adverbs and conjunctions.

SoCo

Routines at School

Pupils will develop their classroom-based routines and independence in the classroom and consider the importance of different routines and the supports that help us become more independent.

PSHE

Elements of Healthy Lifestyles

Pupils will describe different aspects of a healthy lifestyle, identify habits that act as barriers to a healthy lifestyle and learn that there is a direct link between a healthy lifestyle and emotional well-being. They will furthermore learn why some foods are healthier than others.

Science

Sound

Pupils will study the physical and audiological properties of sound. They will experience a range of sounds, make and change sounds independently and locate and identify different types of sound.

Humanities

Mapping skills

Pupils will learn how to use a compass, follow directional language, read grid references and use a map to find their way.

Music

Ensembles and performance skills

Pupils will be taught what it is to be part of a musical ensemble. They will begin to learn the skills required to perform as part of a group and work together to create a piece of music. Pupils will be introduced to different performance techniques such as gesturing, maintaining a beat, following a leader and confidence on stage.

Drama

Anti-bullying

Pupils will use a range of dramatic strategies to explore why people bully, create a performance to demonstrate their learning on how people can work together, and use drama techniques and exercises to develop speaking and listening, interaction, confidence building and audience skills.

Computing

Microbits

Pupils will learn how to experiment with coding and programming to achieve a range of outputs on a microbit. They will follow instructions accurately and understand the importance of precise instructions.

Cooking

Flour Power

Pupils will show developing confidence and competence in the cooking area. They will develop their skills in the kitchen and apply their knowledge and understanding of ingredients and healthy eating. They will design and create dishes by following instructions and evaluate their dishes.

PE

Multi-skills

Pupils will consolidate and develop specific skills which they will use in a range of sports and games. They will build on their ability to follow instructions and to work in small teams. Pupils will further develop their hand-eye coordination and kinetic coordination. Pupils will develop their ability to move with good timing, build stamina, and lead a small team in a warm-up.

Pupils will learn about photography and mark-making techniques. Pupils will each create a mixed-media composition around the theme "Portrait" for the 2024 Unique Arts Award competition.
