

Pupil Premium Statement 20/21

Allocation

The funding allocation was for 6 Primary pupils between September and March. This was increased to 12 primary pupils from April 21.

The funding allocation was for 5 Key Stage 3 pupils between September and March. This was increased to 9 KS3 pupils from April 21.

Total Pupil premium received: £24,178.

Focus: engagement and enrichment

We used this funding to employ additional staff and therapists to give additional support to eligible pupils; each disadvantaged pupil benefited from additional time from at least one of these.

This included each of the following

Additional TA support

Art Therapist: £9,250 (1 day a week) Yoga teacher: £8,910 (1 day a week) Karate teacher: £1,800 (1 session a week) Street dance: £323 (2 sessions a week)

Additional funding came from the school's enrichment budget and the Primary Sports Grants.

Outcomes

Pupil progress data analysis indicates 18 of the 20 pupils eligible for Pupil Premium funding made expected or above expected progress towards the targets set for them.

The remaining two pupils achieved 97.2 % and ((.6% of their predicted targets respectively.
