May saw the start of our Career Assemblies. Each Friday a different speaker will come to Spa Bermondsey to talk about their job, the skills they used, what they did at school they helped prepare them for this role and give advice about how to get into their industry. Our assembly program will run throughout June. We have had some civil engineers who have worked on traffic calming measures in and around Bermondsey and the media manager from Millwall FC come and speak about their roles.



Some pupils in KS4 and 5 had workshops delivered by The Nest, an organisation that supports young people and their families with issues around mental health and wellbeing. Pupils workshops focused on the types of language people use when talking about their mental health and explored different ways to look after your mental health. We also had a very well attended parent workshop on exploring good mental health for parents and carers. We know that these are popular sessions and hope to make them a regular event for parents and carers.

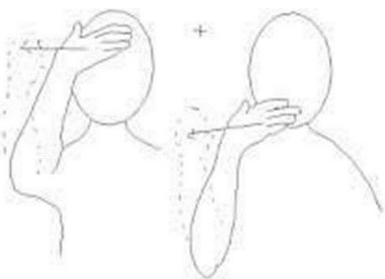
