

Pupil premium summary

In 2018-2019, we received £46,672 for pupil premium for 60 pupils. We used this funding to employ additional staff and therapists to give additional support to eligible pupils; each pupil benefited from additional time from at least one of these. This included each of the following for 1 day per week

- Occupational Therapist: £10,890
- Art Therapist: £3,250
- Dyslexia teacher: £10,075
- Yoga teacher: £9,450
- Trampoline coach: £29,825
- Karate teacher: £1,800

Additional funds came from the school enrichment budget

Our pupil progress data showed no meaningful gap between the progress of disadvantaged pupils and other pupils
