Be Safe

Logins and passwords are for you and your parents only; keep your details private. Your portfolio can only be seen you and your teachers; other children cannot see it. If you are worried about anything, sending a message on your portfolio can be a good and safe way to ask an adult for help.

Ensure an adult always sees pictures or videos you've created and get their permission to upload them.

The adults in school will help keep you safe by checking work before it's published on your portfolio.



Be Kind

Only send positive messages to classmates and the adults supporting you.

Use respectful language that is appropriate for school in all your work.

Support your friends and classmates and celebrate the remarkable things they do.

Be Fair

Make time to share devices with brothers and sisters, they have work to do as well. Support your brothers and sisters if they can't use ClassDojo as well as you.

Be patient; teachers will mark your work and give you feedback, but this may not happen straight away, especially if you add work in the evenings or weekends.

Always do your best
