Dear parents / carers,

I hope this letter finds you well, and that you are all keeping safe and well. This has been a very challenging half term for very many reasons, and I thank you all for the fantastic support you have shown through the Class Dojo system.

I am writing to you today with a few updates that will take place after half term. Thank you for taking the time to have a read through these.

School re-opening

As you will be aware, school will remain closed to most children until at least March 8th. This means that our remote learning provision will continue for at least 2 weeks after half term. We are expecting an announcement from the government on February 22nd about what the plans are for re-opening school. As soon as we have this information, I will write to you all again.

Staffing changes after half term

After half term, there are a few staffing changes in school as some of our temporary staff contracts come to an end. These changes are outlined below:

- Mrs Hill (EYFS) will be starting a new role at Norden school in Rochdale. We wish her every success at her new school, and will miss her greatly. Her class will be taught by Miss Agnew. Miss Agnew currently works in school with Year 1, and is very much looking forward to supporting our youngest children.
- Both Mr Carrington (Year 6) and Mrs Keating (Year 2) are leaving Spring Hill at half term; we thank them for the support they have shown to the children in the time they have been here. This has led us to make some changes to the teaching staff in Years 2 and 6, as follows:
 - Mrs Gales is going to work alongside Mrs Adams as class teacher in one of our Year 6 classes.
 - Mr Tracey is moving from Year 2 up to Year 6, a swap with Miss Wrightson who is moving from Year 6 to Year 2. This has been agreed with both teachers, who are very much looking forward to working with the children in these classes, and which I know will be a fantastic opportunity for the children for the rest of the year.
- A few of our teaching assistants are also moving to support different year groups, to ensure that we are best able to support children across school.

On the back of this letter is a breakdown of the staff structure which will be in place after half term. Even though the school will be closed until at least March 8th, as mentioned previously, the new teaching structure will begin after the half term.
