Dear parent / carer,

We have now been back at school for just over a week, and it has been so wonderful to see all of the children again, playing with their friends and learning together. A special thank you to all our staff in school who helped make the transition for all children returning as calm, happy and as safe as possible.

It is really important that you continue to follow the current government's lockdown guidelines whilst outside of school. This is vital to keep everyone in our school community as safe as possible. We politely ask that you do not mix with other families unless they are part of your support bubble. We really want to try to avoid any closures of bubbles which would result in your child having to complete their learning at home again. Thank you for your help and understanding, and thank you to all parents who continue to wear face coverings around the school grounds.

Please take a moment to read the following notices:

**Photograph day**

On Thursday March 18th the school photographer will be in school taking photos of all children. Due to logistics surrounding coronavirus restrictions, these will be individual photos only – we cannot have group or family photographs this year.

Please make sure your child is in full school uniform on this day. For children in Year 3 and Year 1 who normally have P.E. on this day, please do not send your child in P.E. kit – children in these year groups should wear their school uniform, but with a pair of trainers instead of school shoes, so that they still do their P.E. lessons.

**Non-uniform day**

On Friday 19th March we will be having a non-uniform day to raise money for Comic Relief. We are asking for a voluntary £1 donation on this day – your child can bring coins to school, and we will collect and quarantine them for 72 hours.

## Parking & drop-off around school

Please can I ask all parents to be mindful of others at the start and end of the school day when you are dropping-off or picking up children in cars. The streets around school can get quite busy, and we need all parents to support the school and each other in remaining calm and considerate when driving at these busy times.

Please avoid using the school car park as a pick-up and drop-off point.

Children in Key Stage 1 are provided with free fruit as a snack.

Children in Key Stage 2 may bring a healthy snack to school in their bags if they wish. This should not contain nuts or citrus.

## School shoes

Please make sure that children come to school on their non-P.E. days in appropriate school shoes – children should not be wearing trainers when it is not their P.E. day.
