Don't forget your beautiful smiles!

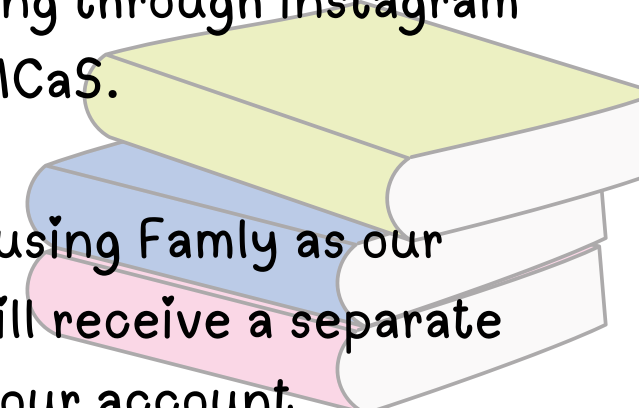


Communication
