## Information

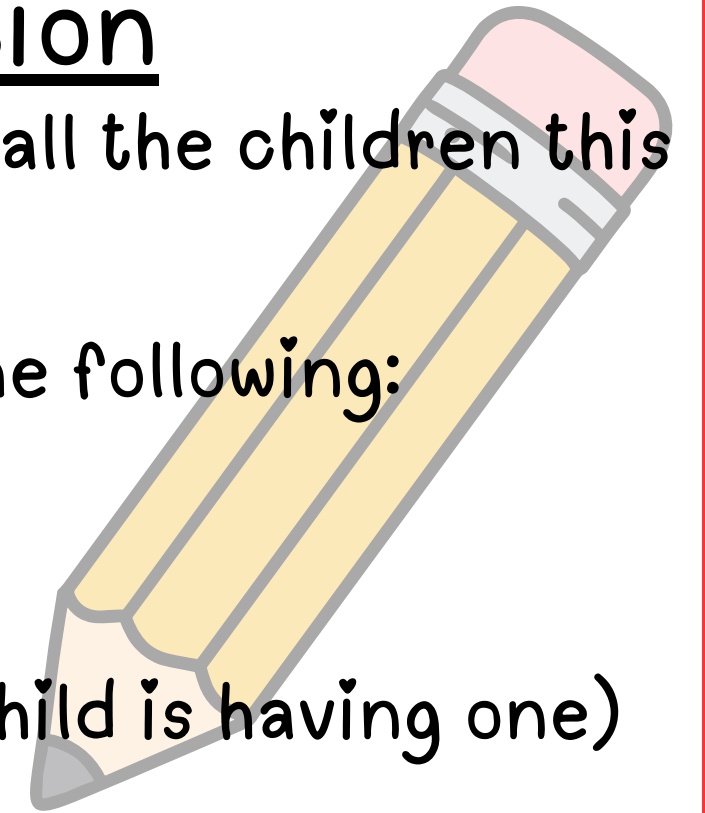
We are very excited to see all the children this week.

Don't forget your beautiful smiles!



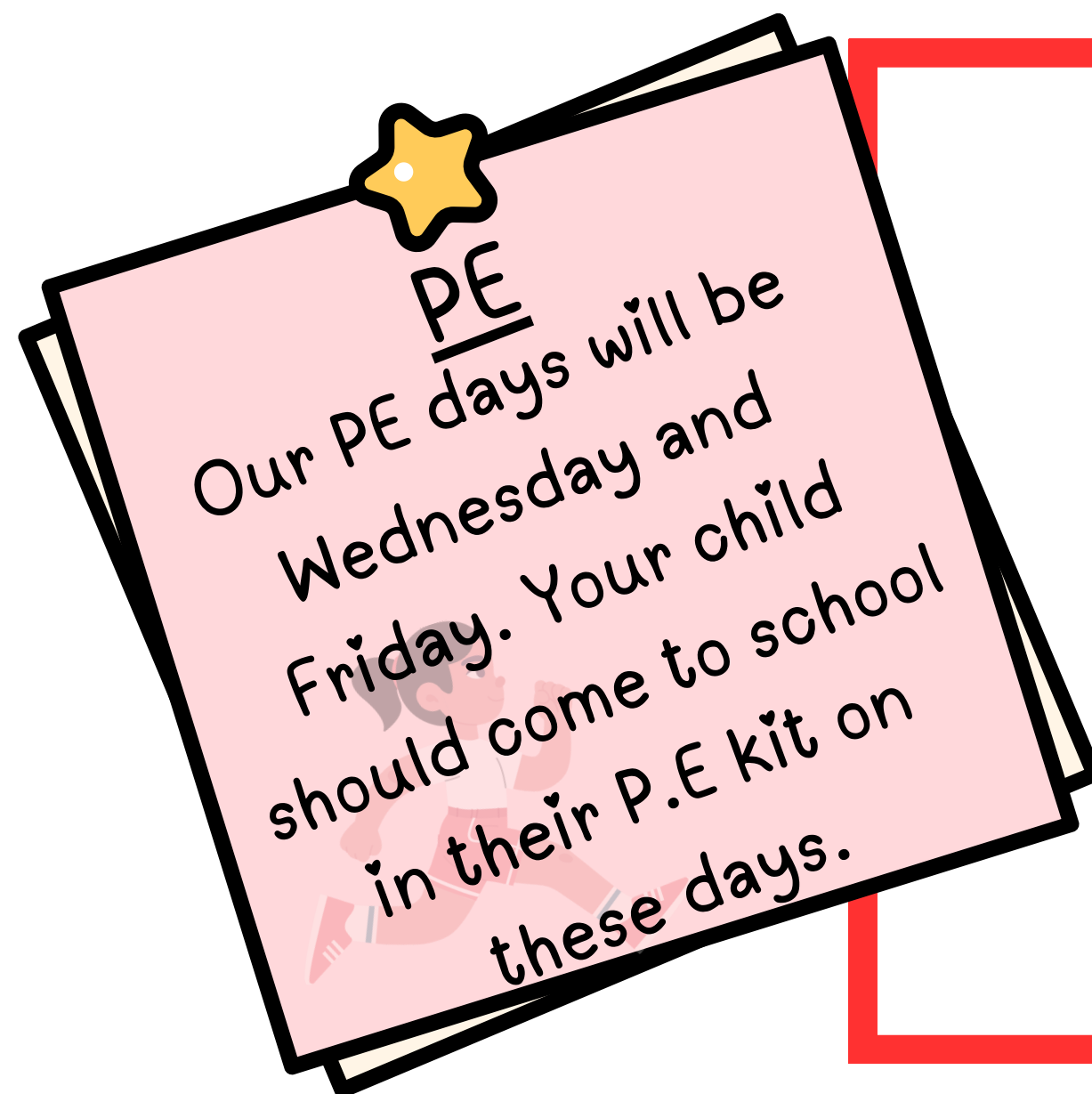
## Reading at Home
