Welcome back

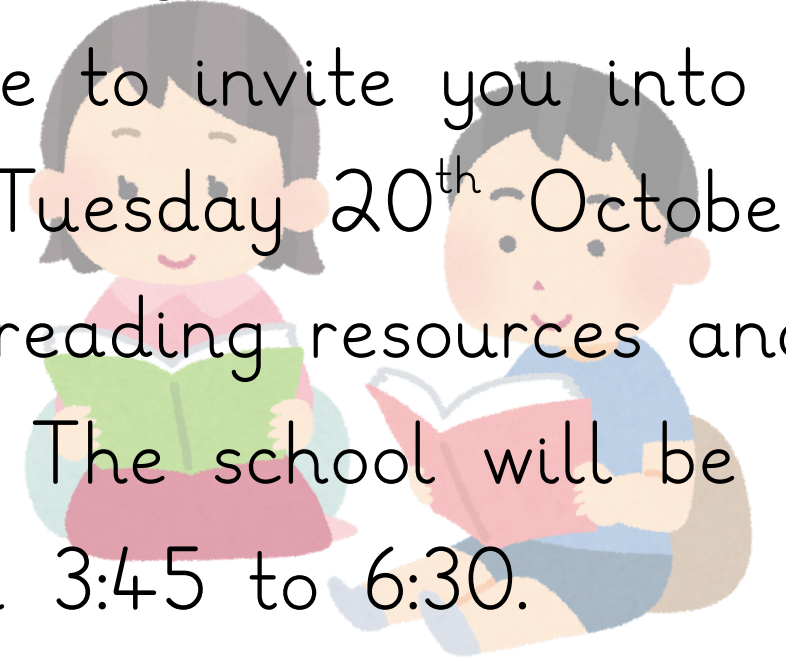
It has been lovely seeing all the children settle in their new classes.

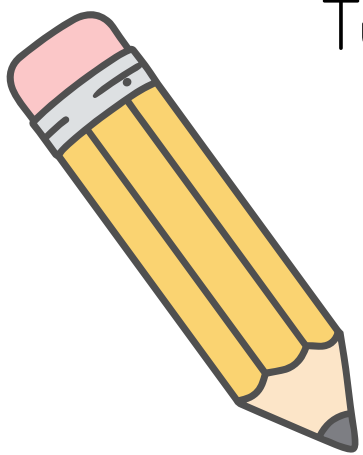

Nursery/Reception Phonics

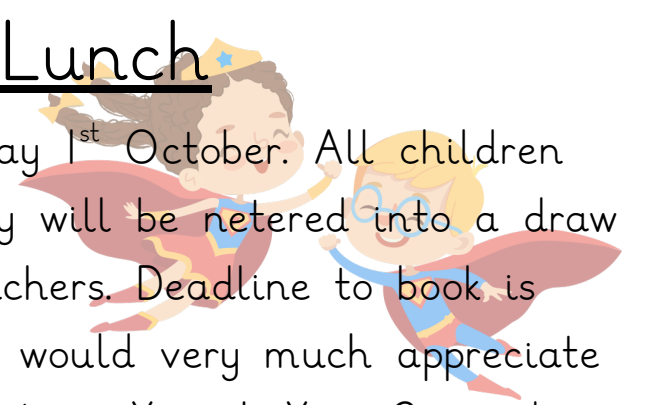
Nursery and reception parents are invited into school at 9.15am on Thursday 15th
