

Take a tally of the different human and physical features depending on the different places eg: shopping areas - tally the different type of shops that you see. Beach, shells, weeds etc.</p>	<p><u>Science -</u> Explore the seasons - create a season 'spin wheel' draw a picture of the weather that represents each season. If you can think of any event / celebration that happen, add in these.</p>
