Care, Collaboration, Challenge

Dear Parents,

In our Personal, Social, Health Education lessons this term we have come to our 'Changing Me' sessions. During these lessons, children will learn how their bodies change over time and the differences between boys and girls. The Jigsaw curriculum that we use is age appropriate and gradually builds up knowledge as your child progresses through school. Below is a brief summary of what will be discussed in each phase, in case your child would like to talk about it with you in more detail.

Reception – senses, body parts, growing up.

Year 1 and 2 – lifecycles, growing from young to old, recognising the physical differences between boys and girls and using the correct names for parts of the body, appreciating that some parts of the body are private, understanding that there are different types of touch and being confident to say what they like and don't like.

Year 3 and 4 – Being unique, having a baby, puberty.

Year 5 and 6 – Self-image, body image, physical attraction, reproduction, puberty.

If you would like to know more information, please do not hesitate to talk to your child's class teacher in the first instance.

### **Mobile Phones**

Unfortunately, children have not been acting responsibly or respectfully with regards to mobile phones in school. Y5 and Year 6 classes have been disrupted. Mobile phones will now not be permitted in school. # **Sports Day**

On 21<sup>st</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> June, we will be holding our sports days. We will be closing the gate at **9:20**; for the morning sports days, Foundation and KS1, this should give anyone wishing to spectate enough time to come onto the school field. The gate will not be re-open until the event finishes at **11:00am**.

Our KS2 sports day will take place in the afternoon and be a longer event. We understand that some parents/carers find this too long and therefore we have split the event into two parts.

• The gate next to the bungalow will open at **13:05 for entry**, and **close at 13:20**. Children will participate in a number of team events.

• The gate will open again at **14:15** for spectators to leave, or to come on to the school field for the second part of KS2 sports day, it will close at **14:25**. Children will participate in competitive running races.

Please ensure you arrive in good time for the event you wish to watch. Unfortunately, we will not be able to open and close the gate other than at times above as it takes staff away from the event. There will be no access to and from the field through the school office.

Children cannot leave early with parents/carers, and should be collected as normal at 15:30.

This year, in order to add a more competitive team element to our sports day, we will be dividing the children in KS1 and KS2 into 4 coloured teams. We would like the children to wear a top of that colour on their sports day. It can be any kind of t shirt including football tops and does not have to be a solid colour, just the majority of it in their colour. We also have some of our old coloured house P.E t shirts available for children who do not have something in their designated colour, so please do not buy something new if you don't want to. Your child will be informed of the colour they need today. Children in nursery and reception should come ready in their Springfield P.E t shirts and black shorts. Please remember to apply sun cream in the morning and send sun hats as the children are outside for quite a long time.
