Communication with Parents

In the last newsletter, I mentioned that we would not be able to hold a face to face parents' evening this term, but teaching staff would phone you to give an update on your child. To make this more manageable, teaching staff will message you on Class Dojo initially, letting you know how your child has settled into the term. If you have any concerns after that, then you can respond via Class Dojo and a phone call can be arranged if necessary. It is really important that you sign up to this, as it is a very good way for us to keep in touch with you and gives you the ability to message your child's class teacher. It also enables you to see the Class Dojo points your child is earning and what they are doing to earn them. Homework is also set on Dojo, so you can see what your child needs to do. If you are having difficulties signing up, then please contact the school office.
