At Springfield, relationship and sex education (RSE) is taught within the personal, social, health and economic (PSHE) education curriculum. Biological aspects of RSE are taught within the science curriculum, and other aspects are included in religious education (RE). These lessons are usually delivered by the class teacher. Prior to the sex education sessions, parents are informed of the content and have the opportunity to view any resources that will be used within them. Parents are given the opportunity to withdraw their children from the sex education lessons if required.
