Learning this Term


Autumn 1 'My World'
We will be learning about ourselves, our families, our school and our community. We will be investigating and drawing simple maps, learning about our 5 senses and talking about how everyone is different and special.

Autumn 2 'Seasons & Celebrations'
We will be learning about seasonal change,
signs of Autumn, and how and why we
celebrate Halloween, Bonfire Night,
Remembrance Day, Diwali & Christmas.

Home Learning

Once we begin our phonics learning, we will be sending letter formation sheets in book bags of the graphemes (letters) covered that week in school. We do not expect them all to be completed every week. They are for you to keep at home for your child to access as you wish. Home learning ideas and activities will also be shared.

We will be inviting you to a short meeting about the phonics scheme we use in school with information about how you can support your child at home and will let you know the date in due course.



Reading at Home

Reading books are matched to your child's phonic knowledge. They will be sent within the next few weeks, following our first assessments. Until then, your child will choose a book from our 'love for reading' library. This book is not for your child to read by themselves, but for you to share together. Please bring your child's book bag to school on a Wednesday. We will send them home every Thursday. If they do not come by Wednesday, we cannot guarantee your child's book will be changed that week. For future reference, please try to read your child's phonic reading book with them at least 3 times weekly.

Before and After School

The gates will be open from 08:55. Any children who ride to school on a bike or scooter must dismount on entering the gates and walk them down the path to the bike shed.
