Communication

Learning this Term

This term there will be one topic, London.
Autumn 1 will be predominantly geography based and the children will learn about capital cities of the UK and will spend time learning about London, our capital city, and its famous landmarks. In Autumn 2, the topic will predominantly be history based, with the children looking at key events in history, including The Great Fire of London and the diaries of Samuel Pepys. In Science, children will be looking at, and exploring different materials and their uses.

Home Learning

<u>Spellings</u>

The children will be set spellings on a Friday to learn at home. These spellings will be based on the phonic phase that your child is working on. Children will be able to log into EdShed.com to access their spelling words for that week and engage in spelling games and activities to aid them. Your support in helping your child to practise their spellings will be greatly appreciated. Spellings will be tested the following Friday. For Year 1, a login will be stuck inside the front cover of your child's reading record. Year 2's login will remain the same.

Maths

Children will have weekly 'Learn It' tests. You will receive this term's 'Learn Its' to practise at home. Year 2's will also receive their logins for TTRockstars to practise their times tables.

Homework Menu

Please look out for our new homework menu for this half term. This will contain a set of interesting and fun activities related to the work being done in class. Children should choose an activity and once completed bring the homework book into class or post a picture on your child's dojo portfolio. Children can complete these at their own pace and are not compulsory, but it is always lovely to see work that you have done together at home!
