Communication



For your child's safety, please can you make sure that you inform the class teacher (at the door in the morning) or contact the school office if your child is being collected by someone other than yourselves.

Learning this Term

This half term, there will be a geography focus. The children will be learning about natural disasters around the world. After half term, we will have a history focus and the children will learn about the Romans. Our first Science topic is 'Forces and magnets,' and after half term we will be studying 'Sound.'

Home Learning

In your child's homework book, there will be a homework menu, with a range of fun and interesting activities. The children can choose which of them they would like to complete. A golden ticket will be rewarded for each piece of homework completed, and during the week, we will share and celebrate their work. Each week, spellings will be set on spelling shed, with a spelling test on Friday.



Reading at Home

Each week, your child will choose either a school reading book or a library book of their choice. Please return their book and reading record before Wednesday each week. Use your child's reading record to ask them questions about what they have read and write a brief comment about how they got on. There is no expectation that they read all their book in one go; please use their reading record to record what they read each day; this could also include books they have at home.

Golden tickets will be rewarded for 3 weekly reads.

Before and After School

The gates will be open from 08:55. Any children who ride to school on a bike or scooter must dismount on entering the gates and walk them down the path to the bike shed. No bikes or scooters should be ridden within the school grounds. For health and safety reasons, the field, trim trail and tyres are out of bounds before and after school and ball games are not allowed at this time.
