Dear Parent

We are currently looking at the possibility of bringing Year 5 children back into school, on a part time basis, before the end of the summer term. Provisional plans would be to offer two days a week, beginning the week commencing Monday 6<sup>th</sup> July.

I would be very grateful if you would contact the school office by Friday 26<sup>th</sup> June to express an interest. We will then get in touch with you to let you know the days that your child has been allocated.

Though this would only give the year 5 children a short time in school, we feel that it would be really beneficial for their well-being to have some actual contact with school before the summer holiday.

Unfortunately, the Year 5 key worker children that are already in school will not be allowed to split their time in school between the new Year 5 class bubble and the Year 5 key worker bubble. We are continuing to follow government guidance which states that children must remain within one group during the week. If you are a key worker, and choose for your child to take up a place in the new Year 5 class bubble, then they will not be allowed to go into the key worker bubble.
