## Forest School Notification: Spring 2

Monday 8<sup>th</sup> February 2021

Dear Parents / Carers,

This is a notification that this half-term the 'Reception Bubble', and 'Year 1 and 2 Bubble' will be working with our forest school teacher each Thursday, beginning Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> February 2021.

On Thursdays, **if your child is in the Reception Bubble**, they must attend school in forest school clothing. I recommend wearing clothes that are old (they are likely to get dirty), warm (especially considering the current weather) and waterproof (if possible). Your child will also need a pair of wellies (or old shoes) and a coat. **Please send your child's full school uniform in a bag for them to change into after their session so they are not left in wet clothes all day.**

On Thursdays, **if your child is in the Year 1 and 2 Bubble**, they must attend school in full school uniform and bring a labelled bag with their forest school clothes into school. As above, I recommend sending clothes that are old (they are likely to get dirty), warm and waterproof (if possible). Your child will also need a pair of wellies (or old shoes) and a coat.

I would recommend all children have multi-layers of clothing for Forest School, and wear gloves and a hat. This is the best way to combat the cold weather that we are experiencing.

Please ensure that all clothing and footwear is clearly marked with your child's name. Take a note of your child's Forest School session this term as this will determine arrangements for clothing:
