
Can you remember where Edinburgh and Cape Town are? Which countries would you find them in?


Look! Here they are on the world map.

Cape Town is the capital of South Africa.








Can you remember some of the physical features you found in Cape Town and Edinburgh?

I am made out of steel and metal.


I have windows.

I am made out of gravel and tarmac.


I have white markings.
