

**What's coming up!****SVP at Ss John and Martin**

Our parish St Vincent de Paul group was set up just a year ago and since then we have been reaching out to help members of the local community in practical ways:

- We run a free community Café every Tuesday afternoon and distribute donated food to those in need.
- We provided beds, bedding, beside tables, a wardrobe, a fridge, carpets and a rug, a microwave and other kitchen items, curtains, a cot, a high chair, a buggy and numerous items of clothing to 17 individuals who approached the SVP for help and who live in our area.
- We receive funding from BCC Warm Welcome to fund our Café
- We received £400 from Veolia for a freezer to store donated food
- We received £150 from ACTS435 to buy a wardrobe
- Our SVP team are Bonita Rennie, Angela Blackwood, Carol Buchanan, Jonathan Chawora, Elaine Christie and Macario Fernandes.

Thank you to everyone who has supported us with donations of food, money, clothing and furniture. We would love some more volunteers to help us in our work. Please speak to one of us after mass.
