

The Synod Pope Francis recently approved the start of a process of accompaniment and evaluation of the implementation phase of the Synod. This is envisaged to be a three-year journey leading to the celebration of the ecclesial assembly in October 2028. This journey will be structured in such a way to offer adequate and sustainable times for the implementation of the Synod's indications, while also providing for some significant moments of evaluation. Archbishop Bernard has reappointed Cannon Paul Fitzpatrick as Synodal Lead for the Archdiocese for a further three-year term.
