<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Boys Winter Uniform</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Navy blue jumper with logo • White shirt (long or short sleeve) • School tie • Grey trousers • Grey socks • Black shoes 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Boys Summer Uniform*</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No changes to the winter uniform for boys apart from they can wear dark grey shorts in the summer. <p><i>*Summer uniform is worn in the Summer Term and can be worn until October half term.</i></p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Girls Winter Uniform</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Navy blue jumper with logo or navy blue cardigan with logo • White shirt • School tie • Grey skirt, pinafore or trousers • Grey socks / grey tights • Black shoes 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Girls Summer Uniform*</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Light blue check dress or light blue playsuit • Navy blue cardigan with logo or navy blue jumper with logo • White socks • Black shoes <p><i>*Summer uniform is worn in the Summer Term and can be worn until October half term.</i></p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Outerwear</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Navy blue coat/fleece (with or without logo) • Winter woollen hats – navy blue or grey • Summer hats – navy blue (with or without logo) • Scarfs – navy blue or grey 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Reception Class</u></p> <p>All items as per older groups for boys and girls apart from boys and girls in Reception wear a light blue polo shirt with logo instead of a white shirt. Reception pupils do not wear a tie.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>PE Kit</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Navy blue shorts (no skorts or hot-pant style shorts) • Light blue polo shirt with logo • Navy blue tracksuit bottoms • Navy blue tracksuit top with logo • Trainers • Children in KS2 will require a navy swimsuit and cap for lessons. 	<p><i>Hair longer than shoulder length should be tied back with blue or black accessories. Hair should not have any patterns shaved into it. Jewellery, including friendship bracelets may not be worn. It is accepted that those children with pierced ears wear plain gold or silver studs but parents are reminded that these present a potentially serious hazard. All studs must be removed by the child for P.E. If your child cannot remove their own studs they should not be worn in school. The school does not accept responsibility for lost studs or watches. Nail varnish or make up are not allowed.</i></p>
