**DEED OF TERMINATION OF CHURCH SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT in
respect of St Aidan's Catholic Primary School, Portnalls Road, Coulsdon,
Surrey, CR5 3DE**

THIS DEED is dated the 1st day of December 2025

PARTIES

- (1) **THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR EDUCATION** (the "Secretary of State");
- (2) **THE SOUTHWARK ROMAN CATHOLIC DIOCESAN CORPORATION**, a company incorporated in England and Wales with company number 00393665 whose registered office is at 59 Westminster Bridge Road, London, SE1 7JE (together, "the Trustees)
- (3) **THE ARCHBISHOP OF SOUTHWARK** (the "appropriate diocesan authority" for the Academy for the purposes of the Education Acts (which shall include the Academies Act 2010)) is also a party to this Agreement in recognition of its role in relation to the Academy ("the Diocesan Authority")
- (4) **ST AIDAN'S CATHOLIC PRIMARY SCHOOL**, a charitable company incorporated in England and Wales with registered company number 10045230, whose registered office is at St. Aidan's Catholic Primary School, Portnalls Road, Coulsdon, United Kingdom, CR5 3DE ("the Company").

together referred to as "**the Parties**".

BACKGROUND

- (A) The Parties entered into an agreement dated 24 March 2016 (the "**Church Supplemental Agreement**").
- (B) The Parties agree to terminate the Church Supplemental Agreement with effect from 1 December 2025 (the "**Termination Date**") on the terms set out in this deed of termination (the "**deed**").

AGREED TERMS

1. DEFINITIONS

In this deed, unless the context otherwise requires, expressions defined in the Church Supplemental Agreement and used in this deed shall have the meaning set out in the Church Supplemental Agreement. The rules of interpretation set out in the Church Supplemental Agreement apply to this deed.

2. TERMINATION OF THE CHURCH SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT

2.1 The Church Supplemental Agreement is terminated with effect from the Termination Date.

2.2 All provisions of the Church Supplemental Agreement, including any which are expressly stated in the Church Supplemental Agreement as surviving its termination, or which might otherwise have done so by implication, are terminated.

3. RELEASE AND WAIVER

Termination of the Church Supplemental Agreement shall not affect or prejudice any claim or demand that either party may have against the other under or in connection with the Church Supplemental Agreement arising before the Termination Date.

4. COUNTERPARTS

This deed may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which when executed and delivered shall constitute a duplicate original, but all the counterparts shall together constitute the one deed.

5. GOVERNING LAW

This deed and any dispute or claim arising out of or in connection with it or its subject matter or formation (including non-contractual disputes or claims) shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the law of England and Wales.

6. JURISDICTION

The parties irrevocably agree that the courts of England and Wales shall have exclusive jurisdiction to settle any dispute or claim that arises out of or in connection with this deed or its subject matter or formation (including non-contractual disputes or claims).




