Strategy

Every St Aidan's child becomes more physically literate, with the knowledge, skills and motivation necessary to equip them for a healthy lifestyle and lifelong participation in physical activity and sport.

To achieve this we would expect indicators to include:

- the engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity and healthy active lifestyles
- the profile of PE and sport being further raised as a tool for wider improvement
- increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport
- broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils
- increased participation in competitive sport.



Action 1

All children at St Aidan's benefit from two one hour sessions of Physical Education each week from Reception to Year 6. The subject is delivered by the class teacher and experienced sports coach who work in partnership to ensure that there is full coverage of the curriculum and that skills and knowledge are sequenced to ensure progression.

- The sports coach teaches seven hours of PE every week across the academic year.

Action 2

The school makes the very best use of the spaces available to it. The MUGA is underused because of concerns regarding the surface.

- Additional maintenance and servicing has now been budgeted for to clean the surface and to establish what ongoing maintenance is required to keep this excellent resource in the best condition possible.
- The sport coach and staff undertake dynamic risk assessments to establish if the MUGA can be used.

St Aidan's has a proud history of participation in a wide range of competitive sports, including tag rugby and cross country. The activities occur during and after the school day and include weekend competitions.
