

Pupils will be able to hold basic conversations involving words, phrases and themes covered in this unit, as well as building in previously learnt vocabulary including practising giving preferences.

Learning Outcomes: Pupils will be introduced to how sentences are arranged and be encouraged to use basic phrases and answer simple questions using days, months, seasons and fruit vocabulary.


