Message from Mrs Greenwood



I hope you have all had a wonderful summer holiday. It has been great to see the children back in school this week, they all look very smart in their uniforms. We have had a fantastic first week back with lots of new learning in all classes. I would like to welcome Miss Grey and Mr Thew to St Aidan's. Miss Grey is teaching in Year 4 and

Mr Thew is the teacher in Year 5. We have also welcomed Mr Szejner and Miss Green who are teaching and learning apprentices and will be working with us over the next 2 years as they work towards their level 3 qualification.

I would like to draw your attention to the holiday list for 2022-23, which is on the website: https://staidansblackburn.co.uk/termdates. We have a 2 week holiday for half term in the summer term from 26th May until 12th June. We have done this so that families are able to book a holiday outside of normal school holidays when it is usually less expensive. It will also mean that you will not be fined for taking your child out of school in term time and your child will not miss any learning time in school. I am unable to authorise any family holidays in term time unless parents are employed in the armed forces or the emergency services or there are exceptional circumstances why the holiday could not be taken in the school holidays.



Just to remind all parents/carers - we are a **NUT FREE** school. We do have some children in school with severe nut allergies. Please do not send any type of nut product into school with your child.

School Uniform and Appearance

The children looked very smart in their school uniform this week. This really reflects the aims of our school and gives everyone a sense of belonging. Thank you for ensuring your children look so well dressed. Please remember that **BLACK SHOES** should be worn at school.

Children are not expected to wear any form of make-up in school, for example painted fingernails, false or gel nails, fake tan or eye make-up. It is advisable that long hair is tied back to help prevent the spread of headlice. Extreme hairstyles (e.g. shaving lines, spikes, gel, dye) are discouraged. We find that a neat, tidy appearance helps to create a good work ethic.

your child's teachers.

Admission to Reception Class & Secondary School 2023

The online admission form for admission to Reception Class and Secondary schools in September 2023 is now accessible using the following link:- <u>https://blackburn.gov.uk/SynergyWeb/Parents/appsummary.aspx</u> If you have a child due to start primary school next September (born between 1st September 2018 and 31st August 2019), please ensure you complete the online admission form. The closing dates are:-

> Secondary Schools – Monday 31st October 2022 Primary School – Sunday 15th January 2023

It is extremely important that these deadlines are met as it can affect your chance of being offered your first choice school.

If you are applying for your child's secondary school place, please read your chosen school's admissions criteria carefully as last year we had some very disappointed pupils and parents who did not get accepted into their first choice of secondary school.

Just a reminder that the Pantomime has been booked at Blackburn Empire Theatre to see Cinderella on Thursday 1st December for the whole school. The cost of this trip is £6.50 and is payable via ParentPay. **If you require a barcode to pay at a PayPoint terminal please let the office staff know.** Payment can be made anytime between now and 1st December allowing you to buy the tickets over this time if you have more than one child in school.

We are aware of the rising costs of day to day living and utility bills and therefore want to recommend spreading the cost. As an example - if a payment of approximately £1.62 was spread over 4 monthly payments from September to December or approximately £2.17 was spread over 3 monthly payments from October to December this would cover the cost.
