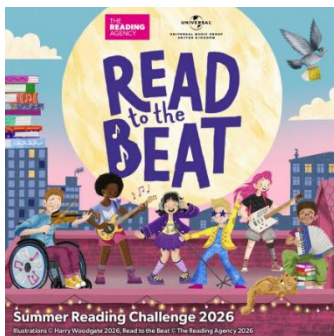
Summer Reading challenge

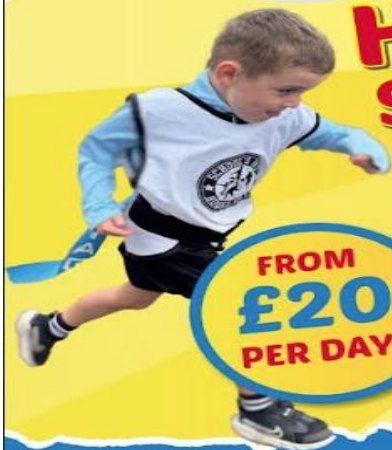
