King George's Hall are strongly advising parents/carers to purchase their tickets in advance and not leave it until the day as some of the performances are close to selling out.

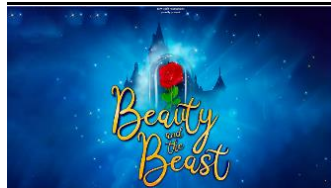

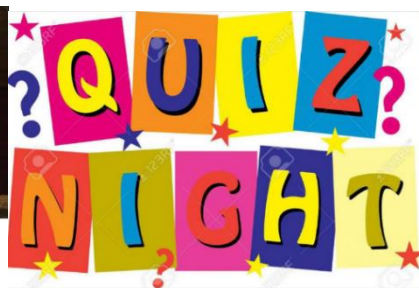
